



Visitors' Code

It can be a worry to have a loved one in hospital and visits from loved ones, family and friends can help a patient's wellbeing and recovery. Follow this code to help keep the hospital safe for you, patients, and staff.

- We welcome visitors between 2pm8pm. Please do not visit if you are feeling unwell. Please wear a face mask when visiting family and friends and sanitise your hands when you arrive. Two visitors for one patient at one time, please; and sit on chairs rather than beds. Respect the privacy and dignity of patients if curtains or bay are closed speak to staff at the nurses' station. Treat staff with respect. Occasionally we may have to close areas to visitors to prevent infection and keep patients safe. We support 'Johns campaign' and take a flexible approach to visiting hours withreasonable adjustments as needed.
