This document summarises the key points of POCT INR testing which should be covered by link trainers during training.

Before Testing	Only to be used on patients receiving treatment with Warfarin
Hints & tips for patients with poor	Ensure a deeper sampling lancet is used, as a larger sample is required than for glucose.
circulation/fingers:	Clean the patients' hands or finger prior to testing.
	 Position the hand / finger downwards to let gravity assist with circulation.
	Wrap the patient's hand in a towel and leave to warm for a short while
	Try gentle massage of the fleshy part of the finger to be tested
	If the finger appears discoloured due to poor circulation even after gentle massage, then DO
	NOT USE
	Once the finger is warm and pink collect a sample

	 Sample is stable for 30 minutes, after which it must be discarded.
