Link Trainer Guide- Key points for iSTAT Alinity

This document summarises the key points of iSTAT Alinity testing which should be covered by link trainers during training.

i-STAT Alinity **Analysis & Cartridge Filling** Fill Mark Indicator □ I-STAT Sample Well

- Sample should be collected into a **dry heparinised syringe** or capillary tube.
- Syringe samples should be analysed within 15 minutes of being taken
- Capillaries should be analysed immediately.
- Once the sample has been taken expel any air and cap your sample.
- Label your sample with the correct patient details.
- Roll your sample between your hands and gently invert to ensure mixing.
- Ensure required cartridges have been brought from fridge to room temperature (~5mins for a single cartridge)
- Set the test up on the meter and ensure patient NHS number is used
- Guidance for sampling will appear on screen
- Remove cartridge from pouch:
 - Avoid touching the sensors or contact pads
 - Avoid holding the calibrant pouch on the cartridge
- Fill cartridge immediately
 - Lay cartridge on a flat surface
 - Place Syringe/capillary at the sample well at an angle
 - o Dispense sample ensuring it travels into the well
 - o Keep dispensing until sample reaches the Fill Mark Indicator



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
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- Close the plastic closure clasp firmly until it snaps into place securely before inserting into meter
- Abnormal results displayed with amber notification light
- Print by holding meter in front of scanner



- **Dispose** of used samples and cassettes as clinical waste
- Clean meter with Clinell Wipes between uses, avoiding liquid entering:
 - A. Cartridge port
 - B. Metal pins under barcode reader
 - C. Gold contacts on the underside of the battery
- **Dock** the meter after use

Troubleshooting and other information



- Any issues must be reported to POCT
- Obtain supply of cartridges and printer paper from POCT
- No Quality Control or External Quality Assurance performed by operators
 - POCT perform QC and EQA
 - o Cartridges perform automatic QC before each patient test
