

Supporting children with handwriting difficulties

Overview and aims:

This course will develop your knowledge of fine motor skill development and how this impacts upon handwriting. It aims to empower you with strategies to support the children you work with who have difficulties with the physical aspects of handwriting, and will give you knowledge and confidence around approaches to work with this group of children to improve their handwriting. It will help you understand the interventions delivered by occupational therapists and guide you on useful resources to have in your toolbox.
