MDT

The Team members specialise in the care and management of breast cancers. All patients are discussed at MDT and the team will agree an individual treatment plan.

Following the meeting, you will be seen in the clinic or ward by a consultant. Your individual treatment plan will be discussed with you and your family. You will be offered a summary of the plan if you would like one.

All patients are offered a named Key Worker (sometimes called a breast care nurse) who will be responsible for co-ordinating care.

The Team members are:

Consultant Breast Surgeon

A Doctor who diagnoses breast conditions and performs breast surgery including reconstruction.

Consultant Breast Oncologist

A Doctor who prescribes drug treatments and radiotherapy for breast cancers.

Breast Clinician

A Doctor who diagnoses conditions of the breast including cancer.

Consultant Breast Radiologist

A Doctor who interprets breast images; mammograms, MRI and Ultrasound and takes tissue samples.

Consultant Breast Radiographer

Interprets breast imaging; mammograms, Ultrasound and takes tissue samples.

Breast Ultrasonographer

Advanced Practice Radiographer

Specialists in breast imaging.

Consultant Pathologist

A Doctor who analyses breast tissue.

Lymphoedema Physiotherapy Specialist

A Physiotherapist who manages arm swelling.

Specialist Breast Care Nurse

A Specialist Nurse that provides information support and help making decisions.

Consultant Cancer Psychologist

A Clinical Psychologist who provides psychological treatment for people affected by cancer.

Research Team

A team that co-ordinates clinical trials and collect data.

Palliative Care Team

Supports the management of symptoms and improves the quality of life for patients.

Breast Nurse Practitioner

Assesses and supports diagnosis, follow-up and ongoing needs.

Surgical Care Nurse Practitioner

Assists with diagnostic and surgical procedures.

MDT Lead

Directs co-ordinated patient care.

MDT Co-ordinator

Team administrator.

Teaching, Training and Research

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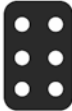
