You are going to see the
Audiologist today.




You are going to York hospital
to get your ears checked.



Go through the main door.



Follow the signs to Audiology.
You can come up the stairs or
take the lift.



Tell the receptionist that you have arrived. The receptionist will check your details on the computer.



The toilets are just before the waiting room, there is also a larger disabled toilet here.



Please take a seat in the waiting room. You may need to wait here for a short time. **Listen** for your name to be called.




Someone will come to collect you from the waiting room.



You will meet the Audiologist
and there will usually be a
Speech and Language Therapist
from the Community Learning
Disability Team.



The Audiologist will have look in your ears to make sure they are healthy.




You may need a hearing test and wear some headphones.



If you need a hearing aid, the audiologist will put some putty in your ear to make a mould. You will need to sit still for this.

The mould of your ear will be sent away and your hearing aid will be made.



You will need to come back to the audiology department to have your hearing aid fitted. This will not hurt.



We will write to you to let you know when to come back to the hospital for this appointment.
