

Working with children with speech sound difficulties: how to support programmes provided by speech and language therapists

Course content:

This course has been requested by schools and settings as a follow up to 'working with children with unclear speech'. It is ideas for those who want to develop a deeper understanding of children with speech sound difficulties and want to understand how to support them effectively. It will cover the different types of speech sound difficulties a child may have, and how speech and language therapists might work on developing their speech, what this might involve, and how to follow a programme given by a speech and language therapist.
