## Why have I been referred to the rapid diagnostic centre?

You have been referred because your GP feels the symptoms you are experiencing need investigating quickly. In some cases this could be a sign of cancer. You will be contacted by a hospital specialist within the next 14 days, who will look into your symptoms and find the best way to manage your care.

### What will happen next?

A specialist nurse will contact you by phone and will need to ask you a few questions to help with the referral. Following this conversation, investigations will then be arranged. The Pathway Navigator will be in touch to discuss these tests with you and give appointment dates and times. These tests may include CT or ultrasound scans and/or an endoscopy.

### Can I bring someone with me to my test appointments?

Due to the COVID-19 (coronavirus) pandemic we ask that you attend any hospital appointment on your own and do not bring anyone else with you. If you require someone to bring you to hospital, they may take you to the main entrance but then must wait for you in the car, or outside the hospital building on foot (maintaining a social distance of two metres at all times).

If you need a relative and/or carer to be with you during the appointment, please phone the Rapid Diagnostic Centre team before your appointment on 07929 184 933.

If you are unable to attend an appointment you must let the hospital know, so that alternative arrangements can be made.

### When will I get the test results?

Test results will be delivered to you during a clinic appointment. This will be either face to face or via a telephone appointment. The Pathway Navigator will discuss your appointment with you in more detail.

It may be helpful to have a pen and paper with you to write down any new information you receive. You may also want to write down any questions you have beforehand.

If you are asked to attend for a face to face consultation, please be reassured that precautions are in place to help keep you safe when you visit our hospital.
