What is Badger Notes?

Your local secondary care maternity provider is using an electronic hand held record to allow women to access their maternity records via a mobile app or via the web. This replaces the previous paper versions of hand held pregnancy records. The electronic hand held record is called 'Badger Notes' and links directly to the woman's electronic medical record in the hospital.

What is the rationale for 'Badger Notes - GP Access'?

We understand that if you see a woman during her pregnancy you will want to have relevant medical information about her pregnancy at your fingertips. In the past a woman might have presented you with her paper hand held record to read; 'Badger Notes GP Access' is a way to do this in the electronic age via a secure web portal. To ensure seamless care along the pregnancy journey 'Badger Notes GP Access' also allows you to document your consultation in a way that feeds directly back into the electronic medical record in the hospital.

How does it work?

This feature is designed to be used during a GP consultation.

The woman clicks 'Share Access' from the Profile Settings Menu in her mobile App or at www.pregnotes.net.

She will ask you for your work email address so she can set up access. She has to agree that she will not use this email address for any other purpose.
