


# Appeals

## York Keep Fitters Meet

## the Olympic Challenge

A group of dedicated York keep fitters, StarStrikers-York, have virtually run, rowed and ridden their way round every one of Britain's Olympic venues. The virtual challenge involved a team of 14 in a daily relay which raised a fantastic £2,122 for the Star Appeal. The team smashed their target of 995km and managed to collectively complete a staggering 3,338km in 31 days.

James and Annika Dowson from Helmsley sadly lost their first child Gypsy in October 2008 when she was stillborn at Scarborough Hospital. Their aim was to raise £300 by walking The Tabular Hills which runs between Helmsley and Scarborough in support of Scarborough Hospital's Maternity Department. It is a 48 mile walk that seemed so appropriate to do since Scarborough was where Gypsy was born and Helmsley is where she now rests. Their target of £300 seems a little underestimated now that they have completed the walk and raised an amazing £1,608.

The Maternity Department are hoping to improve the bereavement services at the hospital and allow families to be together in a warm and homely environment.
