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| 1. Sedation <i>Due to excessive systematic opioids or clonidine</i> | → | (1) Turn-off pump (2) Contact Pain Clinic |
| 2. Low Respiratory Rate <i>Due to excessive systematic opioid</i> | → | (1) Turn-off pump (2) Contact Pain Clinic |
| 3. Low Blood Pressure <i>Due to effect of local anaesthetic or clonidine May feel light-headed or nauseous</i> | → | Contact Pain Clinic |
| 4. High Sensory or Dense Motor Block <i>Due to local anaesthetic. May complain of heavy legs, tingling in fingers, feeling tight chested or difficulties deep breathing</i> | → | (1) Turn-off pump (2) Contact Pain Clinic |
| 5. Signs of Local Wound or Systemic Infection | → | Contact Pain Clinic |
| 6. Leakage of CSF or Blood from Wound Site | → | (1) Turn-off pump (2) Contact Pain Clinic |
