

Important Information after eye drops applied for eye screening.

Tropicamide 1.0% and Phenylephrine 2.5% eye drops

We use these drops to make the pupils larger than usual, so that the photographer can take photographs of the back of the eye.

You may experience blurring of vision.

Please do not drive until your pupils have returned to normal size and your vision has recovered.

Following this appointment if you experience any pain or severe discomfort in or over your eyes, or worsening vision, please contact your local hospital.
