Following your recent treatment, we will ask you to attend annual routine follow-up mammogram appointments. For your mammograms, you will be under the care of the symptomatic services and you will receive appointments from the York and Scarborough Teaching Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust.

If you are 50-71 years old, you will continue to receive letters offering you routine breast screening appointments from the National Breast Screening Programme.

If you receive an appointment letter from the National Breast Screening Programme, please contact the screening office on 01904 725590 or 01904 725591 or email: yhs-tr.northyorkshire.breastscreeningservice@nhs.net and inform the service that you are currently under follow-up care and do not require this appointment.

When you have completed your follow-up, you can return to the National Screening Programme for your normal screening mammogram every three years.

Please note that if you are taking part in a research trial for your follow up care the same information applies.
